1st Starter

Sapatio Mtsvane 2021, Georgia Kakheti (Vg, V)

Georgia is a forgotten jewel of the wine world, thought to be the original source of wine 8,000 years ago. Mtsvane is a star white grape, fermented in stainless steel to capture all its bright, fresh peach fruit and zesty crispness.

or

Averys Fine Riesling 2021, Germany Pfalz (Vg, V)

It's an aromatic, dry Riesling from Pfalz, known for some of Germany's finest Rieslings. Classically styled, with charming white peach, crisp green apple, citrus, floral and mineral notes.

2nd Starter

Zind Chardonnay - Auxerrois 2020, France Alsace (Vg, V)

Zind is unique. It comprises Chardonnay with Auxerrois. There both varieties retain an enticing freshness, while pure, long hours of sunshine bring ripeness. So much ripe-pear aroma, the lemony freshness is more than enough to carry the generous body.

or

Collezione di Paolo Chianti Riserva 2019, Italy Tuscany, (Vg, V)

From Tuscany's highly regarded Rufina area, aged in oak barrels for 14 months, this is long, complex and silky 2019 Chianti Riserva, which is a notch above most others thanks to his meticulous methods and the position of this estate.

Main Course

RedHeads Night Of The Living Red 2021 Australia

A gorgeous full throttle red from the RedHeads team in deepest Barossa, it combines spicy Durif with cassis-scented, old-vine Cab and exotic, spiced Touriga. This wine is full of rich black fruit and spice with firm tannins.

or

Domaine Francois Berthenet Montagny Tete Cuvée 2021 Burgundy

This rounded white from the Berthenet Family has been long-aged on the lees to lend a creamy weight to the aromas of fresh apples and peach, this is a wonderful example of a Montagny.

or

Hunter's Pinot Noir 2020, New Zealand Marlborough (Vg, V)

This is beautifully crafted Marlborough Pinot Noir, aged in part-new barrels for 10 months to lend layers of complexity to the fruit. The cliffhanger 2020 vintage enjoyed top conditions for this grape too. Clean and smooth red. Delicious, just as good as the Californian Pinot Noirs.

Pre Dessert

Seifried Estate Sweet Agnes Riesling 2019, New Zealand Nelson

Sweet Agnes is pure, late-harvested Riesling crafted from naturally 'raisined' grapes from the stony soils of their Eden Road vineyard.

Wonderfully complex Riesling with spicy citric flavours, hints of marmalade and honeyed. it's a delight on its own or with apricot tart.

or

**Domaine de Durban Beaumes de Venise 2019,
France Beaumes de Venise AOC (V, Vg)**

Made from 100% Muscat resulting in a highly aromatic, opulent and delicately coloured dessert style wine. The nose displays a heady bouquet of orange blossom and apricots that leads onto a wonderfully honeyed palate of ripe peaches and yellow plums.

Dessert

Royal Tokaji Blue Label 5 Puttonyos 2017, Hungary Tokaji Aszu (Vg, V)

A regular Gold medalist, this sublime 5 Puttonyos Tokaji is a modern interpretation of this Hungarian classic. It's from the superb Royal Tokaji Company, founded in 1990. The 2017 is rich, sweet and complex with dazzling intensity and freshness.

Final Course

Le C du Chai Cuvée Noble Bordeaux 2020, France Bordeaux (Vg, V)

Dry, yet still complex with rich and citrusy fruit. The golden white result is refreshingly dry but honeyed with a nutty complexity. With its toasty notes and lemony zing, this white is top with cheeses.
